WORK DESCRIPTION	Orientation to safety, grade checking, lubrication, general maintenance, excavating and other types of earthmoving, compacting, paving equipment, such as, but not limited to backhoes, loaders, dozers, scrapers, rollers, and all compaction equipment, and all type paving machines, etc. Hoisting-type equipment such as but not limited to derricks, hoists, piledriving rigs, Tower Cranes, forklifts, or similar equipment. Stationary-Type Equipment such as Air Compressors, pumps, electric generating plants, all forms of drilling and boring equipment, crusher operations, concrete batch plants and hot plants, grade setting, and earthwork.
WORKING CONDITIONS	In-climate weather, outside, exposed to extremely hot and cold weather. Will work in-doors as well. Noisy and dusty conditions. Moderate to minimal physical activity. Required to wear personal protective equipment such as hard hats, safety glasses, hearing protection, safety shoes, gloves, etc.
TRAINING	An Apprentice will be required to complete 4,000 to 6,000 hours of On-the- Job Training and 288-432 hours of related instruction at the Training Site. Training and curriculum will be based upon work description for heavy duty repairman & Welder. Hours are based on where you are sent for Employment.
